







downtown kalamazoo

About nine years ago, during the summer going into my sophomore year of high school, my family moved from Nebraska to Illinois, where I began to attend a new school. During my first year there, I received lots of attention from people. I loved the feeling it gave me, and I slowly began to depend on it. The desire for people's approval rooted itself so deeply in me that it ultimately ended up leading me on a journey of disordered eating. I didn't realize it at the time, but I loved having control. My body image, food intake, and people's perception of me were something that I had control over, while the external transitions not so much. I developed a need to be desired and accepted through the avenue of how I appeared. This was a sin that quickly took root in my heart and developed weeds in my life. I never saw it coming as I was always confident and content in who I was, and I loved the Lord and knew His word deeply. I led bible studies, volunteered a majority of my time at church, led worship at school and church, etc. How could a struggle like this be taking over my life?

This problem began to change every part of who I was. It took a toll on my family relationships, friend relationships, physical health, and mental health. It caused a ripple effect of issues in my life that I never saw coming. Things like selfishness, lying, lust, and anxiety began to take root in my life. I developed an idol of looking and feeling a certain way - skinny. I started not to know life apart from anxiety, small bites of food here and

there, and running two more miles at home after coming home from a two-hour soccer practice.

In my freshman year of college, the Lord came to my rescue. I was alone in my dorm room and couldn't go another day in this bondage. The Lord brought me to an understanding of the heartbreak I was causing Him, and His kindness drew me to repentance. Breaking down, I died to myself that day. I felt the power of physical chains falling off of me. I had to run and tell someone, so I immediately Facetimed my parents. They met me with such grace as they listened and allowed me to exhale years of pain that had been built up. I was now exposed, and darkness trembles with light. "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the Glory of the Lord is upon You". Isaiah 60:1.

I had no idea what was to come, but I knew He was breaking chains, I was lighter, and I was healing! Through a long year of professional help and community, the Lord redeemed my story. When I say redeemed, I mean FULLY healed. Not a single harmful thought has been thought. Not a care in the world about how I look or feel. I have been completely healed. Living in bondage wasn't my story anymore. I felt like a kid entering the Kingdom of heaven—fully at peace. Now I am Abbie. I am free and light with a redemption story that I will never keep to myself. He called me out and saved me when I finally died to myself and chose Him over sin.

Since then, my husband Aaron and I moved to Kalamazoo in September 2020 and have been attending Radiant Church. We have found our home here as we have been drawn in by the beautiful people that attend, and the obvious presence of the Spirit. About a year ago, the Lord gave me a vision at the BOLD Conference that Aaron and I were serving at, and it brought my whole story full circle. It was an odd day when a large handful of people told me how beautiful I looked. As people spoke these things to me throughout the day, I began to process with gratitude how wildly different my perception of that word had become from what it used to be. That evening, the Holy Spirit gripped me in a moment during a worship set, and I couldn't stand any longer. The song "What a Beautiful Name" was playing, and I fell to my knees while He so clearly gave me a vision. It was an image of myself with a mirror on my stomach. The mirror ricocheted the gaze of everyone who looked at me and was met with the beautiful face of God. Immediately following the vision, He gave me the phrase, "from image oriented, to image bearer." I am an image bearer. He is the beauty that I carry. Not bearing the image of Abbie Chenoweth, but the profound privilege of bearing the image of The King.

Radiant Groups are designed to be a smaller, more intimate expression of our church body. Our small groups embrace the DNA and core values of Radiant Church. We lead people to become radiant disciples of Jesus Christ in the context of group study, fellowship, and service. full-time

Our Full-Time program is for every young adult, who has a desire to follow Jesus, to live life differently than those around them and be equipped with practical ministry skills to make a difference in their generation.

45 students

3 states

270 hours of class 120+ hours of outreach and a 6 week mission trip

part-time

Our Part-Time program is designed for working adults who want to take the next step in practically walking out their faith! With a curriculum designed for once-a-week evening classes, students learn how to study the Bible, pray, fast, disciple, and evangelize from Radiant pastors and leaders. The 8-week terms run September through May.

launch

Our LAUNCH program exists to give working adults the training and practical ministry experience that they need to pursue God's call to vocational ministry. The program was launched in fall 2022 with its very first cohort.

Tremember the first time I walked into the Cancer Center in July 2020. I experienced a weird disconnect. I thought to myself, "What am I doing here? I don't belong here with all of these sick people." The longer I sat there, the more uncomfortable I felt. I couldn't wait to get out of there and grab my "real" life back. My mind told me I was a strong, healthy woman. The assessments told a different story. The facts and the feelings didn't align, and I didn't want them to. I had bigger and better plans for my life, and this couldn't be God's plan for me!

I somehow felt a deep sense of shame connected with this cancer. I couldn't shake the feeling that, in some way, I must be responsible for this mess and all the ways it had and would continue to impact everything in our lives. I wondered if I could've done something different to prevent this diagnosis. All I knew was that I had so many questions and not many answers.

I felt fragile and needed to encourage myself for what I knew would be a serious challenge, so before my first surgery, I decided to get a tattoo. I had some pretty flowers and Joshua 1:9 inked onto my forearm to help me remember what God had commanded Joshua "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." I know that my faith in Jesus is the only reason I've been able to be strong and courageous in the face of this illness. He knew what was ahead because

He'd already been there, so even now when I look at the three delicate flowers and scripture verse on my arm, I feel His presence with me, encouraging me to fight the good fight and believe that He's in control.

Even when the pain was intense and the obstacles looked daunting, I knew I could be at peace because He was with me. Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." He also declared, "I am with you always...even until the end of the age." He didn't leave me to face my disappointments alone but sent the Comforter to be with me, to speak peace into my soul, and to guide me into all truth. If fear is a liar, then praise is where my healing has come from.

I'll never forget singing with Dave on the way to and from appointments, in the MRI tubes, or throughout this rocky road to recovery. The Bible says God inhabits the praises of His people, so I have counted it a privilege to have been a worshiper for many years. There's nothing I'd rather do than sing with whatever good or bad feelings are within me. At the end of the day, my joyful noises are all songs of authentic moments giving my sacrifice of praise to Jesus.

If the last 18 months of surgeries, radiation treatments, tubes, and appointments have taught me anything, it's been to cherish every day, every experience and memory. It's to be

present and grateful for what I have and not what I want. Despite dealing with some of the lingering leftover effects of cancer treatment, I declare myself cancer-free in Jesus' name. I am pressing in and pressing on in leading a small group here at Radiant, contributing to the prayer ministry, and doing whatever else the Lord shows me to do. Yes, I have scars. The truth is, everyone has them; Physical, emotional, and/or spiritual. We all have had setbacks and stuff to deal with. The ups and downs of each person's life are distinct but not unique. There's nothing He doesn't understand. Every story has its twists and turns, but they all have a purpose. It's a dance with the Lord that sometimes looks like a Tango and other times looks like a ChaCha with three steps forward and two steps back. But the experiences are never wasted. When the pieces of our broken human condition align with God's glorious design, that's where we find the truest picture of who we are in the light of our magnificent God.


The financial goal for Big Give 2022 was set at \$500,000 with objectives clearly defined and communicated to the church as a whole.




TREE OF LIFE

When Radiant City Music was doing their live capture for their first album, I showed up just a few minutes late ready to spend some time in the Lord's presence! I had heard that kids were welcome in the sanctuary, so I brought my three kids, ages two-six, into worship with me. As a mom, you always do your best to prepare for whatever setting your kids will be in, and I thought I had shown up that evening with enough snacks and activities to keep them preoccupied, but unfortunately, that was not the case

As the evening continued, my kids wanted to get closer and closer to the stage, and I was battling trying to let them be children while also trying to keep them at an acceptable noise level for the recording. While doing these things, I was struggling to be able to even enjoy and engage in worship myself. My frustration was mounting. I remember just standing there and praying, "God, do you see me? I am trying to come and sit at your feet and be in your presence, but this season feels impossible. I'm trying, Lord."

I came to my seat to find my journal and write down some of what was happening. When I was finished, a woman touched my shoulder, saying she had a word for me. My first thought was, "oh boy, what was this going to mean or be?" and I responded with, "ok" in an apprehensive voice. She said, "I heard God say that He is delighting in this, that you've brought your kids here, and that they are experiencing Him like this." I immediately

began to cry. She continued on with what the Lord wanted to share with me, and it was exactly what I needed to hear. I thanked her for hearing the Holy Spirit and sharing that word with me. I told her that not even five minutes before she had shared it with me, I was praying about that very thing.

The Lord used her to send me an immediate response to what I was seeking from Him. It was one of the craziest moments I had experienced to pray, and not for world peace or something "big" but rather something as tender and intimate as, "Lord, see me! See this effort. Oh, I'm falling apart, but I'm trying!" and He answered, "I do see you, child. I do. And I am delighted."
