Radiant Church was born with a mandate from God to build a praying and worshipping church that would strengthen the body of Christ and reach the world.

ince 1996 we have seen God move miraculously in response to the faith and commitment of His people to this call. There isn't enough space or time to recount all of the divine interventions that have brought us to the place that we find ourselves today — He has made a way where there hasn't been a way in the natural and opened ridiculous doors of opportunity that have been beyond our wildest dreams. We have not been called to step back, sit it out or slow down. In fact, I sense the Holy Spirit calling us to step forward, stand up and stretch out in order to reach more people with the message of the gospel, and to see our city, our nation and this generation, become more Radiant.


When Jesus told His disciples to stay awake, it was a command to stay calibrated to the new day of the Kingdom of God, which is the home of every believer. Don't allow your heart to get calibrated to the darkness. Resist it by staying in the light of revelation and the presence of the One we serve. The goal is for you, me, and the rest of God's people to not only stay in the light but understand the full implications of our calling to be the light. The Bible is clear that there would come a time upon the earth in which darkness would reach its zenith and the result would be spiritual pressure and heaviness.

In the prophetic passage of Isaiah 60:1-2 lies a promise. It is a promise as well as a commanding invitation to the people of God to respond and become who we were always meant to be.

I believe that part of what it means to stay awake is awakening to what God is doing, and about to do, in our day. It's stirring ourselves out of the slumber of this fading age. The world is looking for hope, and the Church is meant to be brokers of that message. Darkness does not have the final word—Jesus, the living Word of God, is the first and final word. It's time for each of God's children to open their eyes and rise from the place of fear, comfort, and indifference—to show forth the brightness of the radiance of our King. It's time for us to Be Radiant!

The Radiant City Vision is the strategy that God has given to us for a new season of impact. There are still so many people on God's heart that have not heard. There are thousands and tens of thousands in our own region that deserve to have an encounter with the Living God. It is time for us to rise up, accept the responsibility and shine... I believe as we do this together, we are once again going to see the goodness and miraculous favor of God upon all that we put our hands to.

AS A CHILD, my family attended a small community church. But as I grew up, I began to hate the religious routine. The enemy started to use religion to discourage my relationship and obedience to Christ. Instead of leaning on Christ and covering myself in His Word, my faith steadily devolved and I was led into a life of weakness and vulnerability.

To fill the void, I filled my life with business. I broke sales records in each of my territories and enjoyed the attached rewards. The achievements I had were absolutely intoxicating. Business was good, so I naturally sought out a religious experience that didn't require any obedience or sacrifice. I only listened to messages that preached that Jesus was great, everybody else is great, and therefore I was great. Everything I allowed into my religious right only reinforced what I wanted to hear.

But I couldn't keep up with the charade. Within years my wife and I were drowning in debt and were living far beyond our needs. Shannon was ready to leave me and I had no idea. Our life was completely empty and unsatisfied. In pure desperation, we finally decided to go check out my brother's church in Troy, MI.

After the first weekend, we were hooked. We decided to attend regularly and join a small group that fall. Through regular attendance, God did miraculous things in our marriage and developed us into willing and committed followers of Christ. I was baptized on August 26, 2010, and that week we prayed the dangerous prayer, "God, do what you want, in and through us."

One year later, without notice, my department closed and I lost my job of twelve years with no savings and triple digit debt. That was not the answer to prayer I had in mind. Four months later I took a job in New Jersey and we started making progress with our finances. It seemed like God was on our side again, so we decided to start a family.

Biological babies didn't happen. Infant adoption failed. Foster care adoption failed. The movie UP came out– that was horrible.

Over these years we experienced so much loss. No one talks about the discouraging side of foster care adoption. Country music singers won't even sing about it. In our case, we had 4 children close to placement, but they were disrupted. A disrupted adoption feels like you put your hopes and dreams in the road just to watch them get run over by a truck. My heart felt forever damaged.

66 But despite a hurting heart, I kept showing up.

Because of that decision, God met me in my pain, and I grew roots that I didn't know I needed. He showed me what was truly important in life, He showed me how to have compassion for those I didn't even notice before, and He showed me a strength that I didn't know I had.

My willingness to keep showing up created a promotion and career transfer to Kalamazoo, where our search for a new church family landed us at Radiant. After multiple attempts to find how I could fit into the church body, Trevor and Laurie Weaver invited me to the prayer partner ministry. I had limited prayer experience, and the position was completely outside of my comfort zone, but I was up for the challenge. Through the prayer ministry, I pushed myself to read the Bible more, learned to better discern the Holy Spirit's nudging, and found new ways to support my decisions with scripture.

constantly asking for us to follow Him. Through daily surrender, in good times and bad, we can follow a path of righteousness and truth.

My life doesn't look exactly like I planned it to look, but I don't care about that anymore. Instead, I want my life to look like He planned. ■






Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in Michigan, and the 2nd leading cause of death for ages 10-34.

Without Fuel, the Fire Dies

WHEN I WAS YOUNG, my family was very involved in church, but by the time I was eight years old it had become an occasional event. I knew God was calling me back, but with no real desire for God left in my household, it was easy to ignore.

In high school I was invited every summer to church camp, and I remember being so on fire for God during those months. But every year when I went back home, the passion would fade and slowly so would the fire I had felt inside. Going home from summer camp meant going back to a cycle of loneliness and depression. I had a hole in my life, and I felt as though no one at home could understand. No one even seemed to care.

The cycle of depression led me into a deep hole where eventually it felt like even God didn't care. If God truly cared about me, how could he allow my own mind to be my own worst enemy?

I struggled with suicidal thoughts daily. I would cry and scream out to God to take me, and I would wake up each morning cursing God for not putting me out of my misery. I became full of anger and resentment, and began to feel disgusted at the thought of Christianity and this God who clearly didn't love me.

God sent the only person in the world who could reach me at that point. After years of isolation, I finally felt cared for by someone.

This feeling grew even deeper when she introduced me to her family. They talked to me about church and God, and my heart slowly began to soften. I began to feel God reach out to me with so much love! While I could feel His love for me grow stronger, I found it difficult to give any love back. That's when I found Radiant.

After every service I would walk away feeling as though God was speaking right to me, and was asking me to fully open up my heart to Him. After all I had been through, my depression began to lift and I finally knew that my home was in His arms!

Without Radiant and the wisdom that has been poured into me through the Holy Spirit, I would never have found God again, I would never have found the strength to pray to Him again, and I would never have been baptised and ultimately saved by His grace.

Today, I can feel myself growing stronger and closer to God each and every day. I know now the only way I could have gone from someone who was truly sickened by Christianity, to the strong and loving relationship I now have with God, was through Him and Him alone.

Project Overview



To accomplish the mandate that God has laid before us, we must invest in expansion. We believe by stewarding and expanding our current facilities, we will be able to make more room for people to encounter God and become radiant disciples of Jesus Christ.

We have prayerfully identified three phases of development that will strategically position us for growth in multiple areas. The total cost calculated by our architectural team, for all three phases, will be 7 million dollars. We're praying and believing that God will provide this amount over the next three years.




